Current & Future (Projected) Feedyard Closeouts: Profit/(Loss)

Closeout projections are for cattle placed on feed by a cattle owner at a commercial feedyard and not for cattle owned by a feedyard and fed at cost or a farmer/feeder utilizing his own feed. Cattle cost, cost of gain, and selling price will vary on a regional basis.

Typical closeout for un-hedged steers sold this week:

- Placed On Feed 165 days ago = June 29th
- Projected P/(L) based on the futures when placed on feed: **(\$37.61)**

Cost of 750 lb. steer delivered @ \$130.80 per cwt:	\$981.00
Feed Cost for 600 lbs. @ \$0.88 per lb.	\$528.00
Interest on cattle cost for 165 days:	\$22.17
Interest on feed cost:	\$5.97
Total Cost & Expense:	\$1,537.14
Sale proceeds: 1,350 lb. steer @ \$108.00 per cwt:	\$1,458.00

This week's Profit/(Loss) per head: **(\$79.14)**

Profit/(Loss) per head for previous week:	(\$41.16)
Change from previous week:	-\$37.98
Sale price necessary to breakeven:	\$113.86

Projected closeout for steers placed on feed this week:

- Projected Sale Date @ 165 days on feed = May 25th
- Sale Proceeds based on the June Live Cattle Futures Contract

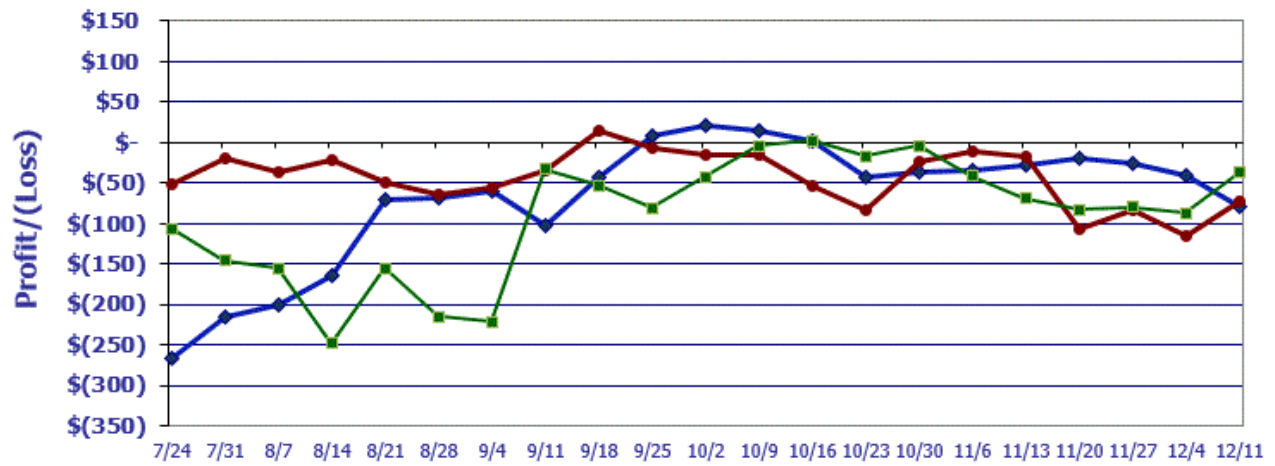
