Abbreviated Market Summary this week because of limited market data available due to the Christmas & New Years Holidays.

Compared to 2 weeks ago, fed cattle trade in Southern Plains and Northern Plains was higher. Feeder cattle and stocker calves trade unavailable. Live cattle and feeder cattle futures were both higher, as were the dressed beef cutouts. Corn was also higher.

Fed Cattle: Trade in the Southern Plains and Northern Plains was 5.00 higher at 197.00 and 200.00 respectively. In the 3 front months, Live Cattle futures closed 2.70 to 5.65 higher. USDA's steer carcass weight data showed weights averaged 953 lbs. this week, compared to 950 lbs. last week and 940 lbs. last year.
